

## Anthem Blue Cross and Blue Shield HP Hot Tip: Proton Pump Inhibitors

Your Anthem patients on nonpreferred products may experience a pharmacy claim rejection. To avoid additional steps or delays at the pharmacy, consider prescribing preferred products whenever possible. Prior authorization and step therapy may apply to select preferred products. Coverage should be verified by reviewing the *Preferred Drug List (PDL)* on the Anthem provider website. The *PDL* is subject to change quarterly.

 All omeprazole prescription strengths and formulations are non-preferred except omeprazole 20mg capsules, which are available for children less than 6 years old only. This is the preferred product for pediatric compounding or difficulty swallowing.

- 3. Nexium/esomeprazole are available as 20mg capsules and tablets. Prevacid/lansoprazole are available as 15mg capsules. Prilosec/omeprazole are available as 20.6mg DR capsules or 20mg ODT tablets, capsules, and tablets.
- 4. Individuals less than one year of age are NOT subject to step therapy through a preferred agent.

**Note**: Quantity limit for proton pump inhibitors = 2 doses/day for OTC Esomeprazole, OTC Omeprazole, OTC Lansoprazole, OTC Prevacid 24 hours, OTC Nexium 24 hours and 1 dose/day for all other PPIs.
